This school with a unique infrastructure, located away from town is ideally suited for running a school. The school is managed by SreeNarayana Mission, Kodungallur- a group of people with missionary outlook and social commitment imbibing inspiration from the exhortation of SreeNarayana Guru to emancipate through education.

Our mission is to provide our students, an academically challenging education that helps them to develop a passion for learning and to achieve a career dream.

Gurusree Public School has three blocks- the Kindergarten, the Primary block , the Secondary and Senior Secondary block. The Kindergarten section with eight spacious classrooms with play equipment and kids park caters to the needs of kids. The three storied public school has twenty well furnished rooms, toilets, auditorium, yoga hall etc. The school has well equipped library, laboratories, digital classrooms and play ground. Sports and games, Karate, Yoga , Art and Music are given emphasis in the school curriculum.

The Academic Year started on 1st June 2020. Due to the Covid – Pandemic situation we started the school with online classes. We conducted online classes from Kindergarten to Senior Secondary. We conducted many extra-curricular activities with the cooperation of our teachers and parents.

CBSE Results March 2020 (Classes X and XII)

A total Number of 43 students appeared for class X Board Examination, out of which 4 students passed with 90% and above, 10 students with 80% and above, 11 with 70% and above and 10 with 60% and above. Total students of class XII who appeared for board examination was 12, of which 1 student (NimmyManilal, Roll No: 24627376) scored full A1 grade and 3 students passed with 90% and above, 4 students with 80% and above and 4 students with 70% and above.

Staff:

Our promising and dynamic teachers are the very pillars of strength and mainstay. Gurusree is indebted to them to all her glorious achievements. We have a panel of 28 teaching staff including a vibrant team of co-curricular teachers for yoga, Karate, Health and Physical education, Drawing and Music. We have 11 supporting staff. Environment Education

School has a green campus with many plants around.

Activities:

Competitions and activities help the children to go beyond the textbook and foster a healthy competitive spirit among the students. The activities are conducted at the school level. During this Covid pandemic situation we conducted all the competitions online. Activities are conducted at school level. World environment day was celebrated on 5th June 2020. Awareness was given about the protection and preservation of environment through a short video. Students were instructed to prepare a vegetable garden and plant trees. A photography competition was also conducted in connection with environment day.

Reading day was observed on 19th June 2020 by conducting reading and speech competition for the students. International Yoga day was observed on 21st June 2020 by demonstrating Yoga asanas. Day against drug abuse was observed on 26th June 2020. Speech competition was conducted.

An online painting and drawing exhibition(Guruprasadam 2020) was conducted. National Doctors' day was observed on 1st July. World population day was observed on 11th July 2020. Independence Day was celebrated. Speech competition was conducted in connection with the Independence day celebrations.

Onam celebrations were conducted on 26th August 2020. Competitions on Recitation, Onappattu, Quiz were conducted online. An online 'Daivadasakam Recitation' competition was conducted in connection with SreeNarayana Guru Jayanthi. Students participated in Fit India Freedom Run and obtained the Certificate. Students and staff have taken pledge on JanAndolanCovid -19 appropriate behaviour and received the certificates.
